We meet the second Monday of every month. After the business meeting, programs feature speakers who cover cultural, social, educational, sports, environmental and other topics that are of particular interest to our members, e.g. “Maximizing Medicare,” Beerfest & Wine Tasting, “The Power Game: Golf & Politics,” History of the D&C Canal and Franklin Township Landmarks, etc. Refreshments follow each meeting.

We perform community services, the most notable of which is the year-round collection of food for the Franklin Township Food Bank and the Summer & Holiday food drives. Our yearly collections total over 5,000 pounds of food and about \$ 2,500 in cash, thanks to the generosity of the entire Canal Walk community.



We fund purchases that benefit all of Canal Walk, such as a defibrillator, a large movie screen for the Clubhouse and park benches for Canal Walk Boulevard.
